The award-winning Weeton & Huby Players present Jim Cartwright's 'Two'. Taking place over the course of one evening in a typical Northern pub, the play famously

features fourteen diverse characters played by just two actors, as various members of the local community pull up a stool and let us into their lives.

Written in 1989 but still astonishingly real today, this much performed two-hander by the celebrated Lancastrian playwright waltzes the audience through a spectrum of



human emotion, weaving a rich tapestry of life in a working class town through intimate insights into the lives of the colourful pub regulars.

Two of our most popular actors, Chris Holland and Chris Corkill, are the pub Landlord and Landlady, bantering and bickering their way through what at first seems like a typical night at the pumps.

The Landlord's banter draws you into his beer stained world, whilst the quick-tongued Landlady, winks and flirts her way through the evening with a Northern warmth and robustness that at first conceals the tragedy behind the couple's relationship.

Now in their 90th season the Weeton & Huby Players have produced 128 plays. Just 7 people have produced or directed 97 of these with Margaret Falcon leading the way with 27 credits. Noel Coward has proved to be our most frequent writer although in recent years, the Yorkshire influence of Alan Ayckbourn, John Godber and Keith Waterhouse has been evident. In 2011 our production in the round of the little known farce, Situation Comedy, won the Trevor Hallatt Trophy for Best Comedy Performance in the Wharfedale Festival of Theatre.

We aim to revert to two plays a year in 2013 and intend to stage our next production 14-16 March.
